- Enrollment limitations - Offered area must be an escarpment and meet practice eligibility requirements. 350 ft. maximum enrollment width.
- ◆ Enrollment limitations - Offered area must meet practice eligibility requirements. Maximum size for filter and recharge areas based upon contributing drainage area.
- ▲ Enrollment limitations - Riparian area practices shall not exceed a maximum average width of 300 ft. (Exception: CP30 = 120 ft.)
- ♣ Practice area may be eligible for Agricultural Drainage Water Management Systems.
- Enrollment limitations - Offered area must meet practice eligibility requirements. This practice is limited to Fulton, Henry, Lucas Counties.
- Land enrolled under infeasible-to-farm provisions shall not receive the per acre annual rental payment incentive.
- Cost share assistance to establish an approved Lake Erie CREP practice shall not exceed 50% of the eligible flat rate costs and shall not exceed 100% of the producer's out of pocket cost.
- CRP-SIP (Signing Incentive Payment) is a one-time payment (subject to availability by USDA).
- CRP-PIP (Practice Incentive Payment) is a one-time payment equal to 40% of the total eligible flat rate cost of practice installation (subject to availability by USDA).

Only new contracts are eligible to receive SIP, PIP, SRR Incentive, and State Incentives.

Any new land enrolled with re-enrolled land may earn the State of Ohio bonus payment, depending on practice type.
