1.	Locations of nearest intersecting road, streams, ditches, ponds and property lines.	
2.	Location and size of proposed project and approximate distances from existing buildings, roads, properties, ponds, streams, ditches, etc.	
3.	Show existing drainage patterns and where water drainage from proposed project will drain Especially where downspouts will outlet on property.	
4.	Indicate property size in acres and show boundaries and building lines. Make the layout plan to a scale i.e. 1"=50' etc. and a North arrow.	
5.	Draw accurately a footprint of the building with dimensions, dimension all existing out buildings, proposed driveway, apron, etc.	
6.	Call to schedule a pre-construction site review at the site location submitted.
